

The Fishery is part of Patshull Park Hotel, Golf & Country Club and is situated amongst wonderfully mature trees and rolling parkland in a beautiful 250 acre Shropshire estate designed by the renowned Capability Brown in the 18th century.

The fishing lodge and four pools totalling 110 acres provide a superb amenity for anglers, offering a choice of trout, coarse and pike fishing depending on the season.

FROM THE NORTH

Follow the M6 to junction 12, then A5 towards Telford onto the A449 to Wolverhampton. Join the M54 at junction 2 and head towards Telford then follow the directions from Junction 3.

FROM THE M40

Take the M42 until you reach the M5, go north until it reaches the M6, exit the M6 at junction 10A and follow the M54 towards Telford. Follow the directions from junction 3.

FROM THE M1

Join the M6 until junction 10A, follow the M54 towards Telford and follow directions from junction 3.

FROM M54 JUNCTION 3

Follow the A41 towards Wolverhampton passing RAF Cosford. After the traffic lights, turn right by the Garden Centre. Continue into Albrighton until The Crown, turn right into Cross Road. At the end of this road, turn right and then left. Follow this road past Burnhill Green and then turn left sign posted Patshull. Turn left at the end of this road and we are located 100 yards on the left.

FROM CENTRAL WOLVERHAMPTON

Follow signs towards A454 Bridgnorth road and continue on this road for about 2 1/2 miles until you reach The Mermaid. Go straight over these traffic lights and then take the next right hand turn onto Tinacre Hill, follow this road and go straight over the next set of traffic lights continuing until you reach the village of Pattingham. Once in the village, continue on the main road bearing right, passing the church on your left. We are situated approx 1 1/2 miles along this road on the right.

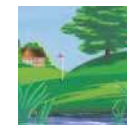
